SUMMARY

We recommend that your honorable body approve the attached legislation authorizing the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways to participate in the above noted Federal Aid project and authorize the County Executive to enter into an agreement with the New York State Department of Transportation. Additionally, we request authorization for the County Executive to enter into an engineering design contract with LiRo Engineers, of Buffalo, New York for the painting of the following Bridges, as approved by the NYSDOT:

Aero Drive Bridge BR 324-1A BIN 3327230, Town of Cheektowaga Central Ave BR 57-1 BIN 3326920, Town of Lancaster Clarksburg Road Bridge BR 715 BIN3327890, Town of Eden Murray Hill Road Bridge BR 710 BIN3328420, Town of Colden North Blossom Road Bridge BR 327-2 BIN3327240, Town of Elma Tannery Road Bridge BR 706 BIN3328760, Town of Aurora

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Erie County will be able to complete \$115,000.00 of additional maintenance work to our bridge infrastructure which is 80% reimbursable by this Federal Aid Project. This resolution commits the required 20% local share for the project in the amount of \$23,000.00 from B.21016, 2010 Bridge Painting Design Program. The negotiated engineering design services agreement with LiRo Engineers will not exceed \$115,000.00.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

To allow the Highway Division to utilize available capital funds to leverage Federal funds to perform much needed maintenance work on Erie County bridges.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

NYSDOT has implemented a Bridge Maintenance initiative to address deteriorating conditions County-wide. Bridge Washing and Bridge Painting must be undertaken to prolong the life of the structures. Under this program, expenses will be reimbursable to the County up to 80%.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

The County will not be able to utilize an additional award of \$115,000.00 in Federal Aid and our bridges will be subject to additional deterioration.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

Highway Division will proceed with execution of agreements in accordance with the Federal and NYSDOT guidelines.

Upon the Erie County Legislature's approval, an agreement will be negotiated and executed with LiRo Engineers, of Buffalo, New York. Once the agreement is executed, design work will begin immediately thereafter.

COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Office of the Comptroller and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient appropriations for the action proposed.

WHEREAS, the Erie County Bridge Painting Project, Six (6) Bridges in various Towns of Erie County, PIN 5759.60 (the Project) is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the appointment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% Non-Federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the County of Erie desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the Non-Federal share of the costs of the Preliminary Engineering (Design V&VI) of this project, PIN 5759.60; and

WHEREAS, the total Project is \$115,000.00 and the County is required to provide the local share portion for the Project in the amount of \$23,000.00; and

WHEREAS, your honorable body has previously authorized LiRo Engineers as a qualified, Term Agreement General Architectural/Engineering firm via Comm.14E-19 of July 17, 2008.

Dear Mr. Sentz:

In order to progress the above referenced project with Federal Aid, we will need Resolutions and Agreements, signed by the County, indicating its commitment to participate in the administration and funding of the various phases of this project.

Based on the NYSDOT Region 5's Capital Program and the Project's approved Initial Project Proposal (IPP), the phases of the subject Bridge Painting Project, along with their current costs, as well as their Federal (80%) and Non-Federal (20%) shares are tabulated below.

Based on the above, we have enclosed a copy of a Sample Resolution and a Federal Aid Project Agreement under which the County of Erle would administer the Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) phase of the subject project. Therefore, the County must commit to pay, in the first instance, 100% of the Federal and Non-Federal shares of the cost of this project phase which currently equals \$ 115,000, (see Table - Agreement Amount). The NYSDOT will, via the process described in Chapter 4 and Appendix 4.2 of the "Procedures for Locally Administered Federal Aid Projects" Manual (available both in hard copy and through NYSDOT's web site at: http://www.dot.state.ny.us/pubs/localprol/local.html), reimburse the County as the project is progressed the Federal share (80%) of the cost of the subject project's Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) phase which equals \$ 92,000, resulting in the current Non-Federal (Local) share (20%) of the cost of this project phase which equals \$ 23,000.

Since this type of project [Bridge Painting (Cyclical Highway Maintenance)] is not eligible for State Marchiselli Program Ald funding, the County is obligated to pay the full Non-Federal share of the cost of the subject project's Preliminary Englagering (Design I-VI) phase.
