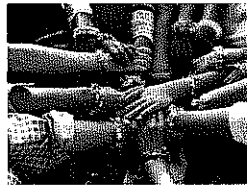

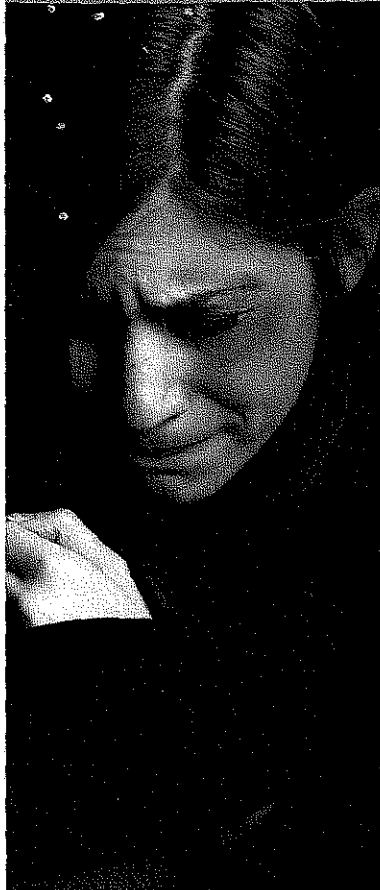

WHO ARE THE VICTIMS?

Victims are forced to provide labor or commercial sex, and can be:

- U.S. citizens or foreign nationals
- Men, women, or children

WHERE DOES HUMAN TRAFFICKING HAPPEN?

Human trafficking can happen in many situations, including in:

- Commercial sex industry (street prostitution, strip clubs, massage parlors, escort services, brothels, internet)
- Factories (industrial, garment, meat-packing)
- Farms, landscaping, or construction
- Peddling rings, begging rings, or magazine crews
- Private homes (housekeepers, nannies, or servile marriages)
- Restaurants, bars, and other service industries (nail or hair salons)

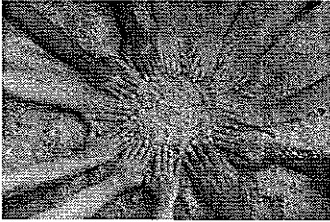

United Hands of Hope House is a non-profit organization that will provide support and recovery services to identified domestic female survivors of human trafficking. Our safe house is going to be the first "safe-house" located in the Western District of New York, covering 17 counties from the Niagara Region to Rochester. Human trafficking is a difficult crime to detect, largely because victims are hidden from public view and the means used by traffickers are many times subtle. Enhancing public safety and providing a safe environment for survivors to recover in is essential in fighting what has been described as "modern-day-slavery."
