RE: Further information regarding Communication 18E-21 (2011)

Dear County Executive Collins:

At the recent meeting of the Community Enrichment Committee on Monday, September 12, 2011 we discussed Communication 18E-21 (2011) regarding funding capital projects for 13 cultural organizations.

There were several questions that arose during the meeting that Legislators would like answered prior to possible voting on this resolution at Thursday's session (September 15, 2011).

- 1) Please provide the Legislature with a complete list of all organizations that applied for capital funding dollars during this process, including the amount they requested and how they indicated they would use the funds.
- 2) Also it appears that a correction needs to be made in the body of the resolution to formally reference Attachment A that outlines each of the projects and what projects the grant will fund.
- 3) Representatives from Graycliff were in attendance and indicated that the funds for their organization would be used to purchase land to complete the original footprint of the estate. The resolution should be amended to reflect that specific use of the funds.

I would formally request that this information be provided prior to the clock-in time of the Legislature on Tuesday, September 13th at 11:00 am.
