SUMMARY

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The Division of Sewerage Management has issued work order WD-5 to Wendel. Under this work order, the consulting engineer will provide an energy conservation study for the Big Sister Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant aeration and blower systems.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On November 29, 2007, the Erie County Legislature passed resolution Comm. 17E-7 authorizing a 3-year Term Agreement with Wendel. At the time of the contract award, the Division of Sewerage Management committed to notifying the honorable legislature of each work order issued.

The Term Agreement was approved to provide the Division of Sewerage Management with supplemental engineering services required to complete the study and design of various construction projects throughout the Erie County Sewer District.
