SUMMARY

Federally declared disasters FEMA DR-1857-NY and FHWA 0902 resulted from the storms of August 2009 which severely damaged the transportation infrastructure of southern Erie County. Multiple repair/reconstruction/replacement projects were generated by the storms many of which qualified for participation in one of the following: FEMA Public Assistance (PA) program, FHWA Emergency Relief (ER) program or the NRCS Emergency Watershed Protection program. The actual and estimated costs of these projects for design have increased as preliminary scoping and engineering progressed. The attached resolution authorizes budget adjustment for anticipated revenue and the purchase of engineering services under the original declaration.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

For projects qualified for FEMA's PA program approved Project costs are eligible for reimbursement, 75% - FEMA; 12.5% - New York State Office of Emergency Management (NYSOEM); and 12.5% - Erie County. For projects qualified for FHWA's ER program approved project costs are eligible for reimbursement, 80% - FHWA (via NYSDOT) and 20% - Erie County. For project qualified for the NRCS Emergency Watershed Protection program approved project costs are eligible for reimbursement, 75% - NRCS and 25% - Erie County. Erie County must pay in the first instance 100% of approved project costs and then apply for reimbursement. This resolution authorizes budget adjustment in B.11023 2011 FEMA Road Design from \$100,000 to \$800,000 which includes anticipated revenue; and authorizes the purchase of engineering services under the original declaration.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

Several of the PA, ER or EWP projects are in design and nearing construction, and slated for construction in 2012. The projects need to be completed in order to address existing storm damage and to continue to address the safety and mobility of the travelling public.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The storms of August 2009 significantly damaged the transportation infrastructure of southern Erie County. As noted above a number of sites qualified for one of the PA, ER or EWP programs making available the funding assistance noted under Fiscal Implications.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

The opportunity to address multiple sites on County Roads that are susceptible to storm damage and only have to bear a portion of the approved costs will be lost. Ongoing construction projects will have to be left partially completed and the affected roads will remain restricted or closed to through traffic.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

Contracts will be negotiated and executed with the approved engineering firms to provide the required engineering or construction engineering services.

COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Comptroller's Office and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient appropriations for the action proposed.

WHEREAS, under the PA, ER and EWP programs, approved costs are eligible for reimbursement from FEMA & NYSOEM; FHWA (via NYSDOT); and NRCS respectively with Erie County providing the remaining share; and

WHEREAS, the actual and estimated costs for completion of design and construction of several of these projects have increased beyond the initial authorization; and

WHEREAS, these projects are in design and scheduled for construction in 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the 2011 Budget appropriation of \$100,000.00 as Erie County share in B.11023 2011 FEMA, FHWA and EWP Match/Road Design Program (Countywide) be increased by anticipated revenue to \$800,000.00 as follows:
