As you are aware, we do send commissary account information to the Comptroller's office on a monthly basis. We feel confident that the pending audit will confirm that the Sheriff's Office administers the Commissary Fund pursuant to New York Codes, Rules and Regulations (NYCRR) and guidelines established by the New York State Comptroller's Office. It will also reveal that the Erie County Sheriff's Office in fact offers some of the cheapest telephone and commissary rates in New York State to benefit our inmate population and their families.

In closing, the Sheriff's Office looks forward to working with the Comptroller's Office and you will receive our full cooperation. We have a scheduled entrance meeting with Erie County Senior Auditor David Kinda on Wednesday, May 23, 2012. Please don't hesitate to contact me with any questions.
