SUMMARY

This resolution is seeking your Honorable Body's authorization for the County Executive to enter into an Agreement Amendment with the firm of Paradigm Environmental Services, Inc. for providing pre-demolition hazardous materials survey at various park locations.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Funds for the project are currently available from the approved and 2012 Capital Budget, SAP Project Account A.12007 – 2012- County Wide Parks Improvements & Equipment

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION

The purpose of the abatement is to ensure that Erie County employees, visitors and the general public are protected from hazardous materials. Once the asbestos containing materials have been removed, the buildings can be demolished.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Parks & Recreation Department has several buildings at various locations that need to be demolished for health and safety reasons.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

The building will further deteriorate with health and safety issues to continue.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The County Executive will enter into an Agreement Amendment with the firm of Paradigm Environmental Service, Inc. for providing pre-demolition hazardous materials survey.

COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

For proposed 2012 bonds, the proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Office of the Comptroller and is related to an authorized capital project for which there will be sufficient funding once the 2012 bonds are sold. The project is included in the agreed upon list of 2012 projects to advance.

RESOLVED, that two certified copies of this resolution be sent to the Department of Public Works, Commissioner's Office, and one copy each to the Office of the County Executive, the Division of Budget and Management, the Department of Parks & Recreation, and the office of the Comptroller.
