Fishing: Currently own a 21' Glastron boat and have owned a 17' Grumman canoe. Fish for walleye, pike, yellow perch, crappie, bass, trout and salmon,.

Use spinning, bait casting, fly, downriggers and ice fishing rods and tip-ups.

Fish streams, inland lakes and the Great Lakes, icefish.

Tie my own worm harnesses, about 500 a year and make my own sinkers, and jigs including painting and adding deer hair and marabou.

Use Downriggers, planers, dipsey divers, jet divers, inline planers ,lead core, and wire line.

Fish: jigs, spinners, plugs, flies. and nymphs, live bait (night crawlers, minnows, grubs, egg sacks.) and have previously had a NY State Bait Dealers License and buy a yearly NY hunting and fishing license license.

Trapping: fox, muskrats, raccoons, mink.

Beekeeper: managed and owned up to 45 bee hives for 10 years.
