SUMMARY

This resolution authorizes transfer of \$15,000 from Other Expenses to Professional Services Contracts and Fees.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There is no fiscal impact to this resolution.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Social Services is developing alternate applications for computer functions currently operated on the County UNISYS mainframe computer. Due to complexity of programming, the software conversion has taken longer than was anticipated at the time of development of the 2012 budget, and an extension of licensing is needed through year end 2012.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The County mainframe computer requires that month-to-month licensing be paid to secure rights of access to this proprietary system.
