## SUMMARY

The highway maintenance building at the Department of Public Works' Division of Highways facility on Cemetery Road in Lancaster requires sanitary and site improvements to the utilities currently feeding the existing buildings and other structures on the site. The site utilities need to be relocated due to demolition of the existing main building for reconstruction of the Cemetery Road Bridge.

The County Executive is requesting authorization from your Honorable Body to enter into an Agreement Amendment with the firm of Trautman Associates to provide professional design services for this project for an amount not to exceed \$22,000.00.

## FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Funds are currently available from the 2011 approved capital budget in SAP Project B.11002.3 – County Wide Highway Facility Building Improvements.

# **REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION**

The utilities such as water, electrical power sewer and gas must be relocated and reconnected due to the demolition of the main maintenance building for construction of the Cemetery Road Bridge.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

An existing highway maintenance building at the Erie County Cemetery Road Highway Facility was demolished as part of a bridge and road construction project. The utilities are currently feeding through the maintenance building and will need to be relocated.

# **CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION**

If the site utilities are not relocated, then operations at the facility cannot take place.

# STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The County Executive will execute an Agreement Amendment with the firm of Trautman Associates Architects/Engineers so the design work can proceed.
