SUMMARY

This resolution is seeking your Honorable Body's authorization for the County Executive to enter into a contract for engineering services with Wendel Companies, Architects/Engineers.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Funds for this contract are available from the approved and adopted 2012 Capital Budget. The SAP project account is as follows:

A.12003-2012-Countywide Code & Environmental Compliance \$253,550.00

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

This project is at the 3rd Phase of the Department of Public Work's (DPW) effort to bring County facilities into compliance with the latest Federal Department of Environmental Protection Agency (DEP) and the State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) regulations.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

When this Administration took office in January 2012, it was discovered that County facilities had been cited for being in violation of various regulations by DEP and fined \$275,000. In addition, the County was directed to correct said deficiencies within 30 days or suffer additional fines. DPW immediately initiated Phase 1 of this project to correct said deficiencies. Fortunately, these deficiencies were corrected within the mandated 30 day period. Personnel training and record keeping deficiencies were also addressed in Phase 1.

Phase 2 of this project was a continuation of our efforts and included correction of additional "potential" violations and installation of a series of above ground fuel tanks.

Phase 3 will include additional above ground fuel tank designs, Oil & Water separator designs, Environmental compliance audits, personnel training, record reviews, and a Universal Waste Plan review.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

DEP and DEC regulations will not be complied with and additional fines will be issued.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The County Executive will enter in to an Agreement with Wendel Companies, Architects/Engineers for Phase 3 of the Environmental Compliance Project.

COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Comptroller's Office and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient appropriations for the action proposed.

WHEREAS, it is also probable that additional environmental code deficiencies will be identified during the course of the design work; and

WHEREAS, an additional contingency amount should be authorized to fund change orders for this unforeseen design work in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with Wendel Companies, Architects/Engineers, for Phase 3 of the Environmental Compliance project in an amount not to exceed \$188,550; and be it further

RESOLVED, the County Executive is also authorized an additional, not to exceed amount of \$65,000 to issue Change Orders for unforeseen contingencies, to Wendel Companies Architects/Engineer's, thereby increasing the total amount of the contract to an amount not exceed \$253,550; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Comptroller's Office be authorized to make payment for all the above from SAP Project account A.12003 – 2012 – Countywide Code & Environmental Compliance, for an amount not to exceed \$253,550; and be it further

RESOLVED, that two certified copies of this resolution shall be sent to the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works; and one copy each to the Office of the County Executive; the County Comptroller; the County Attorney; and the Director of the Division of Budget and Management.
