SUMMARY

The award of Contract No. 71 to rehabilitate sanitary sewers along Roseview Avenue, West Quaker Road, South Davis Street, Broezel Avenue, and Iroquois Avenue in Erie County Sewer District Nos. 3 and 4 is requested.

The necessary bid tabulations, Engineer's estimate, Engineer's recommendation, and suggested resolution for award are enclosed.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There will be no impact on the County's General Fund. The funds for this contract will be allocated as follows \$72,057.45 from Erie County Sewer District No. 3, Capital Account C.00062 and \$100,533.11 from Erie County Sewer District No. 4, Capital Account C.00072.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

Completion of the sewer installation project will allow Erie County Sewer District Nos. 3 and 4 to maintain sanitary sewer service and reduce infiltration/inflow. Hydrolawn of Buffalo, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder of the six (6) contractors that submitted for this project.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

During the course of operation/maintenance activities completed by sewer district staff, several sanitary sewer system deficiencies were identified as needing repairs. This work requires and outside contractor to complete. The scope of this project includes the replacement of approximately 475 lineal feet (LF) of 8" and 10" diameter sanitary sewer, 145 LF of building lateral sewers, and a new sanitary sewer manhole along Roseview Avenue, West Quaker Road, and South Davis Street in Erie County Sewer District No. 3 and Brozel Avenue and Iroquois Avenue in Erie County Sewer District No. 4.

Plans and specifications were prepared for the purpose of receiving bids. Construction bids were received on October 25, 2012. A total of six (6) bidders submitted on the project, with Hyrodlawn of Buffalo, Inc. being the lowest responsible bidder.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

The consequences of not approving the award of this contract will be the risk of further degradation of the sanitary sewer lines leading to potential sink holes and the continued treatment of ground water and stormwater. In addition, loss of sanitary sewer service could lead to basement back-ups thus endangering public health.


STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The low bidder will be issued a Notice of Award and the Department will initiate the process of executing the contract documents.

COMPTROLLERS OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislature has been reviewed by the Comptrollers Office and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient capital appropriations for the action proposed.

Engineer's Recommendation

Bids were opened for Contract No. 71 on October 25, 2012. A copy of the bid tabulation and engineer's estimate are attached. Hydrolawn of Buffalo, Inc. was the low bidder with a base bid of \$140,460.56 and total bid of \$170,590.56. There were six (6) bidders on this contract. The next lowest base bid was \$142,773.35 from New Cal Construction, Inc. We feel the bid amount is a good, competitive number based on the close proximity of those two bids. While the Division of Sewerage Management has had very little experience working with Hydrolawn of Buffalo, Inc. the references provided by Hydrolawn of Buffalo, Inc. all provided very positive reviews of their experiences working with Hydrolawn of Buffalo, Inc.

We believe Hydrolawn of Buffalo, Inc. is capable of handling the work associated with this contract. Our recommendation is to award Contract No. 71 to Hydrolawn of Buffalo, Inc. at a total bid of \$170,590.56.
