I HEREBY CERTIFY THAT *at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 18th day of July, 2013 A.D., a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:*

WHEREAS, E. David Rebmann *is celebrating his retirement after 50 years in education, 40 of which were spent working for the Orchard Park Central School District; and*

WHEREAS, E. David Rebmann *this year has what he calls "four grandchildren". David has taught these students' parents and their parent's parents also; and*

WHEREAS, E. David Rebmann *began his career teaching migrant workers through a federally sponsored program, and in 1971 was hired by the Orchard Park Central School District, working with students at the middle school level and teaching over 7,500 students in his Social Studies classes over the years; and*

WHEREAS, E. David Rebmann *served in the Vietnam War, where he directed medevac operations for wounded and dying soldiers, and taught GED classes to soldiers; and*

WHEREAS, E. David Rebmann *holds four college degrees, three of them graduate, and was a Fulbright Scholar to the Middle East; and*

WHEREAS, E. David Rebmann *is involved in the American Legion, Orchard Park Symphony Orchestra, and is director of the Orchard Park Youth Bureau and Youth Court; and*
