Dear Mr. Polancarz:

We are a group of nine licensed practical nurses working at the Erie County Correctional Facility. Our title of "medical aide" is due to the use of military terms in the Jail Management Division.

We perform the exact same duties, for the same employer in the same department, and for the same inmates that the medical aides (LPNs) do at the Erie County Holding Center. They are represented by the Teamsters' Union, we are represented by CSEA.

We are coming to you because of an unfair, unjust situation. The Teamsters and County settled a contract for their medical aides with a new pay scale reflecting a substantial wage increase after reviewing what the average salary of other correctional LPNs in Western New York were receiving.

We petitioned our union to bargain for wages that mirror the wages of the Erie County Holding Center's medical aides. The petition was never even brought to the bargaining table for the County to consider or even be made aware of. Yet, union dues continue to be withdrawn from our paychecks at a rate of \$48 per month. We were told, when we questioned CSEA that since there are only nine of us in a union of thousands, it's the majority that gets heard.

Since January of 2013, an LPN with no experience and just out of school starts at the Erie County Holding Center at \$20.10/hour with an immediate 2% raise totaling \$22.30/hour

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with their final step giving them \$33.77/hour, that is not including the 8% in raises over the next three years they have coming.

The medical aides at Erie County Correctional Facility, performing the exact same job, start at \$17.23/hour with their last increment giving them \$19.16/hour. I have worked at the Erie County Correctional Facility for twenty-two years. I earn \$19.16/hour with no hope of any increase, especially since the union blatantly refuses to acknowledge our needs. Does this seem at all fair to you?

All nine of us at Erie County Correctional Facility are dedicated Erie County employees with impeccable time and attendance records. We work hard together as a team trying to deliver the best possible nursing care. This drastic wage difference really makes us feel like, "Why bother?" nobody appreciates our efforts anyway.

In the past we were part of the Corrections' Section of CSEA and we felt we were represented fairly by them. When the Health Department stepped into the Jail Management Department, the correction section transferred out into a unit of their own. The Health Department put us in a unit comprised of secretaries, data processors, and clerical staff. No one with an understanding of our needs for our job informed us of the transfer.

We are asking you to transfer the nine of us, "Correctional Facility Medical Aides," back into the Corrections' Unit of CSEA. We feel we stand a better chance of representation from them since we work side by side, facing the same hazards day in and day out for the Jail Management Division. Their union representatives are fully aware of the job we do.

We still need to put gas in our vehicles and maintain them to come to work, pack a lunch to bring to work, pay for sitters for our children, pay for clothes to wear to work every day, and pay to launder them. We do not receive any type of uniform allowance like the rest of WNY Correctional LPNs are receiving or current, up to date wages.

You could right this wrong by helping us earn the same wages the medical aides at the Holding Center earn for working for Erie County, effective as soon as possible, and seeing that our unit of nine is transferred to the Corrections' Section so they can work with the County to get us a contract.

I have included copies of the current wage scales so you can see the drastic differences.


