I Hereby Certify, that at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 26th day of September 2013, A.D. a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:

WHEREAS, Kiwanis Clubs are located in 80 nations and help their communities in countless ways by working together, and;

WHEREAS, Kiwanis Club members achieve what one person cannot accomplish alone, members work on service projects and raise money every year for communities, families and projects, and;

WHEREAS, The all-volunteer Kiwanis organization includes Kiwanis Clubs, K-Kids Clubs in elementary schools, Builders Clubs in middle schools, Key Clubs in high schools, Circle K Clubs in colleges and universities, and the Aktion Club program for developmentally disabled adults, and;

WHEREAS, Eric Paul of West Seneca has been a long-time member and served as a past president and of the Kiwanis Club of West Seneca, and;

WHEREAS, Eric Paul is currently serving his second term as lieutenant governor for the Niagara Frontier South Division, and;

WHEREAS, Eric Paul was elected New York District Kiwanis Governor at the 96th annual district convention held August 14-18, 2013, at the Rochester Institute of Technology Inn and Convention Center, and;

WHEREAS, Eric Paul will take over the position on October 1, and then will become the Kiwanis New York District Governor, the volunteer chief executive officer for the Kiwanis family of organizations in New York State, and;

WHEREAS, Eric Paul is the first Western New Yorker to hold the position in 16 years, previously, the late Jim Yochum, also from West Seneca, served as governor, and was Paul's sponsor to join the group in 1983.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this legislative body pause in its deliberations to honor Eric Paul on being named Governor of the New York District Kiwanis.
