
RE: Goodrich Road (CR 216) - Design/Rehabilitation - Town of Clarence

SUMMARY

This resolution seeks authorization to award engineering services for the Preliminary Design for the Rehabilitation of Goodrich Road (CR 216) in the Town of Lancaster to Clark Patterson Lee, as Engineering Design Consultants.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The funding available is SAP B.13016– 2013 Capital Road Overlay Program.

REASONS FOR RECOMENDATION

Goodrich Road is a minor arterial road in the Town of Clarence and is highly traveled. The deteriorating condition of the road has made it difficult for the traveling public. Failure to address the conditions of the road will cause continuing deteriorating road conditions.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

For the past several years the County has oiled and chipped this road in an attempt to preserve its rideability without much success. The County is, therefore, undertaking the current project to resolve the long-standing pothole and cracking issues on Goodrich Road.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION


The current conditions on Goodrich Road will continue to have a negative impact on public mobility and safety.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The County Executive will enter into an Agreement with the engineering firm of Clark Patterson Lee for providing Architectural/Engineering services to provide the design and construction documents so work can commence.

COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Comptroller's Office and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient appropriations for the action proposed.

RE: Goodrich Road (CR 216) - Design/Rehabilitation - Town of Clarence

WHEREAS, long stretches of Goodrich Road have been susceptible to severe potholes and cracking in the winter months making the road difficult to drive in those months due to the condition of the roadway surface; and

WHEREAS, over the years, the Department of Public Works has been using oil and chip as a repair measure; and

WHEREAS, the only solution is to rehabilitate the road by strengthening it and repaving to make a smooth surface to drive on; and

WHEREAS, before construction can commence, this road is in need of design; and

WHEREAS, funds exist in SAP Project number B.13016 – (2013 Capital Road Overlay Program) for work on Goodrich Road (CR 216); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works desires to use these funds to begin preliminary design work on this roadway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature authorizes the County Executive to enter into a contract for Engineering Services for the preliminary design of the Rehabilitation of Goodrich Road (CR 216), in the Town of Clarence with Clark Patterson Lee for an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, SAP Project B.13016 – 2013 Capital Road Overlay Program, will be utilized to perform the necessary study and preliminary design of Goodrich Road (CR 216), in the Town of Clarence; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature forward three (3) certified copies of this resolution to the Department of Public Works, Office of the Commissioner, and one copy each to the Office of the County Executive, the Division of Budget and Management, and the Office of the Comptroller.


