Janis took on challenges and among her accomplishments she upgraded the Orchard Park Police Department, established the implementation of the KRONOS timekeeping system and brought all of the department heads together for better communications; and

WHEREAS, Janis Colarusso has not had the opportunity to see the hope of a new Senior Center come to fruition during her tenure as supervisor, but her heart will always be with the seniors and will assist in all ways to make this a reality; and

WHEREAS, Janis Colarusso was named Erie County Town Clerk of the Year in 2003 by her peers. She is a member of the Chamber of Commerce and has served as a director and secretary. Janis has taught religious education at Nativity of Our Lord Church and has served on their council. She also is a member of the Hillcrest Fire Hall Ladies Auxiliary.
