I HEREBY CERTIFY, That at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 8th day of May, 2014 A.D., a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:

WHEREAS, Mark P. Mondanaro is a resident of the Town of Tonawanda , the husband of Pamela, father of Mark and Megan and proud grandfather of Zachary and Brayden; and

WHEREAS, Mark P. Mondanaro graduated in 1978 from the State University of New York Oswego with a Bachelor of Arts in Secondary Education with an English Concentration; and

WHEREAS, Mark P. Mondanaro graduated from Texas A & M in 1987 with a Master's Degree in Educational Administration, and also completed graduate work at the State University of New York at Brockport as well as the College of St. Rose; and

WHEREAS, Mark P. Mondanaro was an English Language Arts teacher for nine years, held numerous building administrative titles, and was Superintendent in the LaFayette Central School District for six years; and

WHEREAS, Mark P. Mondanaro has been the superintendent of Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda Union Free School District since July of 2007, instituting strong academic and financial planning in the district; and

WHEREAS, Mark P. Mondanaro, with Ken-Ton Board of Education, has worked on the reorganization project for two years in an effort to maximize efficiencies at the building operational level, while stabilizing the mid to long range financial plan and maintaining student programming and opportunity at the same time.
