I HEREBY CERTIFY THAT at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 22ND day of May, 2014 A.D., a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:

WHEREAS, Donald A. Ogilvie is a resident of the Town of Hamburg, the husband of Jane, father of Sarah Gardner, Moriah Ogilvie and Nathan Ogilvie and the proud grandfather of 4grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, Donald A. Ogilvie received Bachelor's and Master's Degrees in Education from Buffalo State College and a Certificate of Advanced Study in Educational Administration from the University at Buffalo; and

WHEREAS, Donald A. Ogilvie began his career as a classroom teacher and team leader in the Williamsville School District and then was a building principal in the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda School District; and

WHEREAS, Donald A. Ogilvie served more than 16 years as Superintendent of three districts: Hamburg Central, Southwestern Central and Chadwicks Union Free School District; and

WHEREAS, Donald A. Ogilvie has been the District Superintendent of the First Supervisory District of Erie County and CEO of the Erie 1 Board of Cooperative Education Services (Erie 1 BOCES) since 1997, making him the longest serving leader of the organization and the most senior district superintendent in New York State, a leadership role he has held for 17 years; and

WHEREAS, Donald A. Ogilvie was the field representative of the New York State Commissioner of Education to 19 component school districts in Erie County as well as school districts and BOCES in other areas of the State and to the Buffalo Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, Donald A. Ogilvie's community service includes being President of the Board of Trustees of the Theodore Roosevelt Inaugural Site Foundation; and a member of the Vestry of St. Paul's Episcopal Cathedral; Vice-Chair of the Board of Trustees of the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra Society; Trustee of Hilbert College; Trustee of WNY Public Broadcasting-WNED; and Board Member of the United Way of Buffalo & Erie County as well as Co-Chair of the 2000 Annual Campaign along with his wife, Jane.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature pauses in its deliberations, to recognize and honor **Donald A. Ogilvie** upon his retirement from Erie County Board of Cooperative Education Services (Erie 1 BOCES), and for his commitment to education and to the people of the County of Erie.
