I Hereby Certify that at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 6th day of February 2014, A.D. a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:

WHEREAS, The Western New York Federal Credit Union was started by and for employees of the West Seneca State School in January 1964, and;

WHEREAS, The Western New York Federal Credit Union was originally known then as the West Seneca State School FCU, the office was located in the basement of the Administration Building on East and West Road, and;

WHEREAS, The Western New York Federal Credit Union was founded in January 1964 as the West Seneca State School FCU by and for employees of the West Seneca State School and was located in the basement of the administration building on East and West Road, and;

WHEREAS, The Western New York Federal Credit Union became fully automated in 1983, creating immense growth and requiring an expansion from the basement of the administration building to a home on East and West Road in 1988, and;

WHEREAS, The Western New York Federal Credit Union continued to grow and purchased the main office building at 7 Willowdale Drive in 1998, and;

WHEREAS, The Western New York Federal Credit Union received Community Charter designation in 2005 that allowed people who live, work, worship or attend school, and businesses and other legal entities located in the City of Buffalo, City of Lackawanna, or the towns of Cheektowaga, West Seneca, Orchard Park, Elma, Lancaster or Aurora to join, and;

WHEREAS, The Western New York Federal Credit Union is a full-service, not-for-profit, member-owned financial institution serving Western New York, and;

WHEREAS, The Western New York Federal Credit Union currently has more than 7,200 members and \$40 million in assets, and;

WHEREAS, The Western New York Federal Credit Union, throughout its growth and expansion has maintained its mission to provide personal and quality service every day, while maintaining financial stability, and;

WHEREAS, The Western New York Federal Credit Union was recognized with the West Seneca Chamber of Commerce "Business of the Year" award in 2013, and;

WHEREAS, The Western New York Federal Credit Union is celebrating its 50th year of serving the Western New York community in 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this legislative body pause in its deliberations to honor The Western New York Federal Credit Union on their 50th year milestone.
