I HEREBY CERTIFY, THAT *at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 13th day of February 2014, A.D. a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:*

WHEREAS, Boy Scout Brandon R. Sullivan of Troop 524, Greater Niagara Frontier Council, Boy Scouts of America, has attained the coveted rank of Eagle Scout, Boy Scouting's highest honor, to be celebrated at his Court of Honor on February 16, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Brandon earned 25 merit badges in his quest to become an Eagle Scout; and

WHEREAS, Brandon's Eagle Scout project was the construction of a 24' x 40' run-in shed for horses at Suburban Adult Services, Inc.' - High Hurdles Therapeutic Riding Program. This program was developed in 1997 by parents, educators & professionals to provide a therapeutic riding experience for children and adults with developmental disabilities; and

WHEREAS, Brandon supervised 78 volunteers, working four days, for the building of the shed. The project, with planning and construction, totaled 135 hours; and

WHEREAS, Brandon raised over \$5,000 for the materials by sending 200 letters to businesses and individuals. In addition, he presented his project to area clubs; and

WHEREAS, Brandon attends Springville Griffith Institute where he achieved the Merit Roll in his freshman and sophomore years and the Honor Roll for his junior and senior years; and

WHEREAS, Brandon is the vice president of both the school band and Future Business Leaders of America; and

WHEREAS, Brandon is captain of the Travel & Varsity Soccer team where he achieved MVP for two years and was selected ECIC All-Star & WNY Exceptional Senior. He is also captain of the Bowling team where he achieved MVP for one year and the ECIC High Series Bowling Award; and

WHEREAS, Brandon also participates in church youth groups, concert, jazz and marching bands, chorus and orchestra. During golfing season he works at the Concord Crest Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, Brandon's future endeavor is the study of physical therapy at Daemen College.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature pauses in its deliberations to acknowledge and commend the outstanding achievement of Brandon R. Sullivan in completing all requirements to attain the rank of Eagle Scout and wishes him well in all of his future ambitions.
