Dear Mr. Messana and Mr. Sickler,

First of all, we would like to thank the DOT for having Sharrows installed on the pavement along Lake Street, Route 75, within the Village of Hamburg.

In our continuing efforts to encourage healthy lifestyles and alternative transportation methods, and raise public awareness of increasing bicycle traffic along our streets and roads, we are now requesting that the DOT install sharrows along Main Street and Buffalo Street in the Village.

At the same time we are requesting that the Erie Co. DPW/Highways to do likewise and install sharrows along Legion Drive, from Buffalo Street to Lake Street as well as on Pleasant Avenue from Lake Street to Rogers Road.

Marking Buffalo, Main and Legion, together with Lake Street, will complete the bike route loop around the Village identified on the GBNRTC Bike Route Map, while marking Pleasant Avenue will address the main route used by bicyclists and walkers/joggers to get from the Village to Lake Erie.
