I HEREBY CERTIFY, *That at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 4th day of December, 2014, A.D., a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:*

WHEREAS, Bernard John De Young, the son of the late Agnes and John Albert De Young, was born on December 15th, 1914, at his home in Malden Massachusetts; and

WHEREAS, Bernard John De Young is the proud father of two daughters, seven grandchildren, 16 great grandchildren and seven great, great grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, Bernard John De Young graduated from Medford High School in 1932; and

WHEREAS, Bernard John De Young graduated from Bentley College of Boston, Massachusetts in 1934; and

WHEREAS, Bernard John De Young enlisted in the Navy Reserve on October 23rd, 1938, and was called to active duty on October 21st, 1940, achieving the rank of Chief Yeoman before receiving an honorable discharge on September 23rd, 1945; and

WHEREAS, Bernard John De Young began working for the Internal Revenue Service on December 3rd, 1945, and continued until his retirement on January 22nd, 1971.

RESOLVED, *the Erie County Legislature pauses in its deliberations to recognize Bernard John De Young on his 100th birthday, and to honor and thank him for his dedication and commitment to his country.*
