Re: Appointment to the Department of Mental Health

Dear Honorable Members:

Pursuant to Article 13 § 1301 of the County's Charter, I hereby appoint Carol Dankert-Maurer to be the Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health. As you may be aware the Department of Mental Health (the "Department") has been without a commissioner since the early Fall and has been overseen by interim Commissioner Deborah Goldman.

Carol Dankert-Maurer's current term as Commissioner of the Department of Social Services expired December 15, 2014, but she is currently still serving in that role on an interim basis. Having Commissioner Dankert-Maurer transition to the position of Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health will serve multiple purposes.

First, Commissioner Dankert-Maurer will bring years of experience navigating the often turbulent waters of addressing the concerns and mandates of state agencies that oversee the Department. Additionally, Commissioner Dankert-Maurer will work especially close with the incoming Commissioner of Social Services, guaranteeing the transition of the new Commissioner will be done as smoothly as possible. Given the complex nature of the Department of Social Services, the administration feels strongly that ensuring a seamless transition from Commissioner Dankert-Maurer to our next Commissioner is paramount.

I would also like to acknowledge and thank Deborah Goldman for her efforts during her time as interim commissioner of the Department. It is my strong belief that Carol and Deborah will be well positioned to continue to provide much needed services to the people of Erie County from this essential department.
