MEMORANDUM

SUMMARY

Approve the attached resolution to allow the Department of Senior Services to expand the faith based group respite initiative to assist memory impaired seniors and their families. The Department of Senior Services requests authorization to extend the contract with consultant, Ms. Lisa Rood, previously approved in 12/18/14 COMM. 25E-18 and to establish additional group respite programs with area faith based organizations providing each of them with a one time payment of \$1,000 to begin such programs.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Budgetary appropriations are available in the Community Service for the Elderly (163CSE1516) grant's Professional Services Contracts and Fees account to cover the cost of contracting with the consultant and churches.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

With a growing older adult population, the Department of Senior Services is working to maximize the impact of its programming by providing new low cost services in partnership with community organizations, including local faith based institutions. To assist in creating the group respite programs we have contracted with Lisa Rood for consultant services. Currently, Ms. Rood has assisted in contracting three faith based institutions and established respite programs at each location. By extending the length of this contract Ms. Rood would be able to create additional partnerships.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In partnership with the faith-based community, the Department of Senior Services is working to increase the availability of older adult group respite programs. Such programs provide a safe, supervised, entertaining environment for memory impaired adults, thereby allowing their family caregivers temporary relief. While loved ones are participating in the group respite program, caregivers can pursue activities that aid the caregiver in maintaining their own health and wellbeing; attend to their own medical appointments, exercise and/or have a break from their daily routine.

Ms. Rood has identified three additional churches that are interested in starting this program. They include: Clarence United Methodist Church, Akron United Methodist Church, aka The Wright Center and Baker United Methodist Church. The Department of Senior Services will be working to identify additional faith-based institutions to partner

on this important initiative to expand services for the county's frail older adult population.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

The Department of Senior Services would be unable expand the faith based group respite program.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The Department of Senior Services will contract with the consultant and churches.

WHEREAS, group respite programs provide a safe, supervised, entertaining environment for memory impaired adults, thereby allowing their family caregivers temporary relief; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Senior services is working to cost efficiently expand services for frail older adults in Erie County by partnering with faith-based institutions to provide group respite programs; and

WHEREAS, partner institutions need assistance in setting up these programs; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Senior Services desires to extend the contract with consultant, Ms. Lisa Rood, for the period April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016 to assist with the creation of additional group respite programs, previously approved in 12/18/14 COMM. 25E-18; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Senior Services has identified three additional area churches to begin this initiative, including Clarence United Methodist Church, Akron United Methodist Church, aka The Wright Center and Baker United Methodist Church; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Senior Services plans on providing each of the identified churches with a one time payment of \$1,000 to cover program start up expenses; and

WHEREAS, budgetary appropriations are available in the 163CSE1516 grant's Professional Services Contracts and Fees account to fund the contracts with the consultant and churches.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County Executive be and is hereby authorized to extend the previously approved consultant contract with Lisa Rood, for the period April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016, to assist with the creation of the group respite program; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive be and is hereby authorized to enter into contracts, not to exceed \$1,000 each, with Clarence United Methodist Church, Akron United Methodist Church, aka The Wright Center and Baker United Methodist Church, to begin group respite programs; and be it further

RESOLVED, that budgetary appropriations in the 163CSE1516 grant's Professional Services Contracts and Fees account be utilized to fund the contracts with the consultant and churches; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the County Executive's Office, the Division of Budget and Management, the Comptroller's Office, and the Department of Senior Services.
