## **SUMMARY**

This resolution is requesting authorization for the County Executive to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Various County Park Buildings – 2014 Demolition Phase II project.

This project involves the demolition of several old dilapidated parks buildings since they are a safety and health threat or are structurally unsafe to occupy for the public.

## FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Funds for the project are currently available from the approved and as adopted 2014 capital budget. The SAP project account is A.14007 – 2014 Countywide Parks Improvements.

#### **REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION**

Several old dilapidated parks buildings are going to be demolished since they are a safety and health threat or are structurally unsafe to occupy for the public.

# **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Clark Patterson Lee performed a structural assessment on several buildings and determined that there are several structural deficiencies which make the structures unsafe and are a hazard to the public. It was also suggested to repair the structure, only if repairs did not exceed the value of the structure. Since the repair costs were excessive, the recommended option is to demolish these structures.

# **CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION**

If demolition to these buildings is not performed, they will remain unsafe and continue to be a life and safety hazard to the public and will have to be closed.

# **STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL**

Upon Legislative approval, the County Executive will enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder so that construction work can proceed.
