WHEREAS, East Aurora's Boys 4x400 Relay Team was comprised of four outstanding runners, Jack Zagrobelny, Mike Durant, Mike Coatsworth and Matt McLaughlin this year, and;

WHEREAS, East Aurora's Boys 4x400 Relay Team broke the East Aurora High School record with a time of 3:22.42, and;

WHEREAS, East Aurora's Boys 4x400 Relay Team added their names to the history books by taking first place at the Allegany-Limestone Gator Relays, and;

WHEREAS, The East Aurora Boys Track and Field Team took home first place at this year's ECIC Track Division 4 meet, and;

WHEREAS, East Aurora's Boys 4x400 Relay Team continued to distance itself from the competition as the members turned in many outstanding performances week after week throughout the season, and;

WHEREAS, East Aurora's Boys 4x400 Relay Team's individual members had outstanding seasons, breaking additional school records and placing first at the Section VI Championships in their respective races, and;

WHEREAS, Mike Coatsworth took 5th place at states in the 400 meter dash, and;

WHEREAS, Jack Zagrobelny placed 3rd at states in the 400 meter hurdles, and;

WHEREAS, Matt McLaughlin was 2nd at states in both the 800 meter run and as a member of the 4x800 relay team, and;

WHEREAS, Mike Durant and Mike Coatsworth placed 2nd at states in the 4x100 meter relay, and;

WHEREAS, East Aurora's Boys 4x400 Relay Team's historic 2015 season included winning the ECIC Team Championship, claiming the Section VI - Division II Title, and winning the New York State Championship at the University at Albany in June.
