SHERIFF

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office, working in conjunction with Emergency Services has identified a grant that would allow for the purchase of a video camera transmitter, two antennas, and software a new security camera for Air-1; and

WHEREAS, the equipment and software will allow Air-1 to share live surveillance images with Emergency Services' command units, both mobile and static locations; and

WHEREAS, the funds will also be used to purchase a steerable landing light increasing visibility during landings; and

WHEREAS, said grant requires a local match of \$40,666.000; and

WHEREAS, there will be no impact on county tax dollars with the appropriation of these funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that \$40,666.00 in available balances in the Asset Forfeiture Trust Fund is hereby authorized for transfer to the appropriate grant fund account in the Erie County Department of Emergency Services as local match for the purchase of a video camera transmitter, two antennas, and software as well as a steerable landing light for Air-1; and be it further

RESOLVED, the Division of Budget and Management is authorized to set up the appropriate accounts for the expenditure of said funds for this purpose; and be it further

RESOLVED, that these expenditures meet the criteria established by the U.S. Department of Justice for the use of equitable shared funds; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies be forwarded to the Division of Budget and Management, the Erie County Comptroller, the Division of Purchase and the Chief of Administration of the Sheriff for implementation.
