

Dear Honorable Members:

The Erie County Comptroller's Office has completed an audit of the Erie County Water Authority (ECWA) Compliance with New York State Public Authority laws and regulations reporting for the period July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Generally Accepted Government Auditing Standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain sufficient, appropriate evidence to provide a reasonable basis for our findings and conclusions. Our objectives were to:

- Document compliance with reporting requirements of the Public Authorities Law for New York
 State in its General Provisions and specific requirements in the enabling legislation therein for the ECWA
- Document compliance with reporting requirements from the Authorities Budget Office (ABO)
 the State Comptroller's Office (OSC) and Erie County.
- Document with any other regulatory reporting requirements from other governmental laws and regulations such as State Finance Law (STF).

We believe the evidence obtained provides a reasonable basis for our findings and conclusions based on our audit objectives.

BACKGROUND

The ECWA is a Public Benefit Corporation formed in 1949 to provide a potable water supply to the residents of Erie County. The Authority was created by an Act of the New York State Legislature, codified in sections 1050 through 1073 of Title 3 (the "Erie County Water Authority Act") of Article 5 of the Public Authorities Law of the State of New York (as amended), to, among other things, finance construct and maintain a water supply and distribution system to benefit the residents of the County of Erie.

OBJECTIVES

A three-member Board of Commissioners, appointed for three-year terms by the Erie County Legislature, is responsible for controlling and managing the affairs of the ECWA. The Commissioners may adopt such rules and regulations for the conduct of their meetings and the management of the ECWA as they deem proper, and not inconsistent with New York State Public Authorities Law (PBA), State Finance Law (STF) or By-laws of the ECWA.

For the twelve (12) month audit scope period, ECWA reporting requirements from various governmental units including the New York State Comptroller (OSC), the Authority Budget Office (ABO) of the Governor's Office and the Erie County Legislature. Both the State Comptroller and Erie County Comptroller's offices have audit authority which include the ECWA.

The PBA has explicit reporting requirements under Section 2800 and contract requirements in STF. The ABO requires specific reports for Procurement, Budget and Operating Results etc., and the OSC has authorities reporting on operating results, debt, head counts, etc.

The audit has been performed by reference to the various authorities reporting requirements under law (PBA, ABO, OSC, NYS Constitution and Erie County) and examining the reports as filed and policies approved by the Board of ECWA on their web and in its minutes. The schedule with specific references is included in the report.

AUDIT FINDINGS

In our opinion, ECWA management has taken steps to include the requirements from the foregoing governmental authorities, especially the Public Authorities Act of 2005, including the additions to it in 2009.

No significant matters adversely affecting compliance with applicable laws, rules, or procedures came to our attention, except as disclosed in this report. Our audit was performed for the objectives previously described and would not necessarily disclose all instances of noncompliance with respect to areas of operation not reviewed.

AUDITOR COMMENTS

Reporting in compliance with applicable law allows the public to assess how money paid to the Erie County Water Authority is invested in the provision of water. Further, the reports offer insight to consumers and others as to the safety of the process of delivering potable water. As such, appropriate transparency is important regarding the filing and posting of reports.

At this juncture, the audit has been performed by reference to the various authorities reporting requirements under law (PBA, ABO, OSC, NYS Constitution and Erie County) and examining the reports as filed and policies approved by the Board of the ECWA on their web and in its minutes. Whatever was not resolved in that manner was resolved with the entrance meeting on December 19, 2014 and subsequent documentation from ECWA reviewed.

WE RECOMMEND

The Reporting Requirements are extensive and as such should continue to be delineated on the web page and available from PARIS reports at the ABO.

RESULTS OF EXIT CONFERENCE

An exit conference was scheduled for December 30, 2014 at 2P.M.with the Management of ECWA. Upon the request of the ECWA and the consent of our office, that meeting was waived in lieu of an email from the ECWA stating that the ECWA found "it to be an accurate report."

In accordance with the County's Audit Response System and Procedures, we request that ECWA prepare a written response to the County Comptroller and the Erie County Legislature by February 17, 2015.
