WHEREAS, *The Erie County Legislature seeks to honor individuals and institutions of Erie County who enhance the quality of life in the community and throughout the county; and*

WHEREAS, *ACV Auctions is a tech company founded in 2014, and uniquely fashioned by CEO Joseph Neiman, CTO Dan Magnuszewski, and CFO Jack Greco, in which a revolutionary online bidding platform for used car auctions was created; and*
