I HEREBY CERTIFY, That at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 17th day of December, 2015, A.D., a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:

WHEREAS, Leonard A. Weisbeck, Sr. was a lifelong Alden resident, graduate of St. John the Baptist School, and Alden High School Class of 1940 where he served as class president; and

WHEREAS, Leonard A. Weisbeck, Sr. served in World War II as a radar operator before returning to Alden and marrying Elizabeth Deitz in 1946, with whom he had eight children; and

WHEREAS, Leonard A. Weisbeck, Sr. purchased the Alden Advertiser in 1959 after his father retired as its publisher; and

WHEREAS, Leonard A. Weisbeck, Sr. was involved in many organizations including the Alden State Bank, Alden Hook and Ladder Company, a charter member of the Alden Chamber of Commerce, the Alden Historical Society, American Legion Post 1377, VFW Post 7967, the Alden Rod and Gun Club, the Kiwanis Club, and the Art Club; and

WHEREAS, Leonard A. Weisbeck, Sr. was named the Distinguished Citizen of the Year in 1992 and received the Lion's Club Achievement Award; and

WHEREAS, Leonard A. Weisbeck, Sr. passed away on December 3, 2015 at the age of 93.
