WHEREAS, *Timothy Horner is a life-long Erie County resident, having received his bachelor's degree in business administration from the University at Buffalo, and studying business and accounting at Canisius College and Bryant and Stratton; and*

WHEREAS, *Timothy Horner gained ten years of experience working in the insurance industry as a treasurer, and financial manager and account manager; and*

WHEREAS, *Timothy Horner moved from Kenmore to Springville in 1987 where he was appointed as the first Administrator for the Village of Springville in 1999; and*

WHEREAS, *Timothy Horner managed over \$6 million of grants as Administrator in order to fund various capital improvement projects that were fundamental to the health of Springville and its residents; and*

WHEREAS, *Timothy Horner prepared annual budgets for the Village, whereby taxes and fees remained lower than 2% of the annual increase, thus providing capital improvements and better conditions for residents; and*

WHEREAS, *Timothy Horner upheld good leadership and remained involved through his many roles in and outside the Village.*
