WHEREAS, On Wednesday, January 7, 2015, having satisfactorily completed her assignment here on this earth, God mercifully called Sandra A. Archibald home to be by HIS side, and

WHEREAS, Sandra A. Archibald was born in Toronto, Canada and moved to Buffalo, New York at an early age; she was an extremely intelligent child and was educated in the Buffalo Public School System; she attended the University of Buffalo where she earned both a Bachelor and a Master's degree graduating with cum laude honors;

WHEREAS, Sandra A. Archibald loved children and taught school at Buffalo's Waterfront and School 31; in 1979, she and her husband opened Main Day Care Center and for the next 25 years provided outstanding daycare to the children of Buffalo; she was considered a day care pioneer and often gave wise counsel to others operating day care centers and

WHEREAS, Sandra Archibald and her husband also owned A & Arch Transport Company with their late son, Sherman Allison; this was a niche' business, where they transported cars across the country for rental car companies and for private customers wintering in warmer climates; they also transported German luxury cars from ships to dealers and managed many rental properties around the city; Sandra Archibald was a shaker and a mover, a true entrepreneur and broke barriers and made advancements in areas seldom accessible to women and people of color during her time, and

WHEREAS, Sandra Archibald was preceded in death by her husband of 31 years, James K. and her son Sherman Allison; she is survived by one son, Bradford Price, a daughter, Yvette Allison, 10 grandchildren and a host of great-grandchildren, other family members and friends,

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature does herein extend its deepest condolences to the Archibald family on the loss of their beloved Sandra Archibald and be it further
