PROPOSED RESOLUTION

Re: Erie County Sheriff's Office
FY2014 Bomb Squad Grant

WHEREAS, the US Department of Homeland Security through the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services has awarded \$110,000 to the Erie County Sheriff's Office in funding specifically allocated to agencies with established Bomb Squads Units; and

WHEREAS, authorization is required from the Erie County Legislature for the County Executive to enter into contract and accept \$110,000 in federal resources to provide funds for equipment to protect the residents of Erie County and the State of New York from terrorist attacks involving explosive devices; and

WHEREAS, there will be no impact on County tax dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature does hereby authorize the County Executive to enter into contract with the New York State Division of Homeland Security to receive \$110,000 in grant funding for the Erie County Sheriff's Office; and be it further

RESOLVED, that authorization is hereby provided to the Division of Budget and Management to establish funding in the Grant Fund 281, as follows:

ACCOMPANYING MEMORANDUM

RE: Erie County Sheriff's Office
FY2014 Bomb Squad Grant

I. Summary of Recommended Action

The attached resolution requests authorization for the County of Erie to enter into contract and receive funding in the amount of \$110,000 from the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services to be allocated to the Weapons and Ordnance Division of the Erie County Sheriff's Office.

II. Fiscal Implications of Proposal

No impact on County Tax Dollars. Funds will provide for equipment to enhance the explosive device operations capabilities of the Erie County Sheriff's Office Bomb Squad.

III. Reasons for Recommendation

Erie County must remain committed to Homeland Security and continue to protect the residents of New York State from terrorist attacks. Use of these funds will allow the Sheriff's Office to maintain a professionally equipped bomb squad. The equipment purchased will further enhance the explosive device response capabilities of the unit.

IV. Consequence of Negative Action

The County will forfeit \$110,000 in funding that would allow the Sheriff's Office to purchase specialized equipment that they otherwise would be unable to obtain. This equipment is vital to the protection of Erie County residents from terrorist attacks involving explosive devices.

V. Steps Following Approval of Measure

Certified copies of this resolution will be forwarded to the County Executive, the County Attorney, the Division of Budget and Management, the Erie County Comptroller's Office and the Erie County Sheriff's Office.
