SUMMARY

Final acceptance and approval of the Erie County Sewer District No. 3 engineering agreement with CRA Infrastructure & Engineering, Inc., formally R & D Engineering in the amount of \$493,686.98 is requested.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There will be no impact to the County's General Fund. The funds for this contract were allocated from the Erie County Sewer District No. 3 Capital Account C.00038.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

All engineering services required by the contract documents have been completed. As a result, it is the Department's recommendation to finalize this Engineering Agreement.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Your Honorable Body in legislative communication 5E-20-(2000) approved the execution of an engineering agreement with CRA Infrastructure & Engineering, Inc. to implement facility improvements at the Southtowns Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility.

The engineering agreement included the design and construction services involved with the upgrade to the existing sand filters and a clarifier at the treatment plant. The improvements have been completed and all services associated with the engineering agreement have been received.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

Contract default on the part of the County of Erie could be claimed by the Consulting Engineer.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

The County of Erie will close out the engineering agreement with CRA Infrastructure & Engineering, Inc.

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Comptroller's Office and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient capital appropriations for the action proposed.
