**WHEREAS**, *The Erie County Legislature seeks to honor individuals and institutions of Erie County who enhance the quality of life in the community through their efforts; and*

**WHEREAS**, *E. Peter Forrestel II is a resident of Akron, New York, loving husband to Linda M. Forrestel, proud father of Eugene Peter III, who married Holly, and Rebecca, who married Jonathan Wood, and grandfather of Ethan Peter, Gabriella, and Baby Wood; and*

**WHEREAS**, *E. Peter Forrestel II graduated from Akron Central Schools; earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Zoology and a Master of Science Degree in Biology from the University of Michigan; obtained a Foundations of Banking Certificate, General Banking Diploma, and an Applied Banking Diploma from the American Institute of Banking; and received a Community Bank Management Degree from the Bank Administration Institute, University of Wisconsin at Madison; and*

**WHEREAS**, *E. Peter Forrestel II began working for the Bank of Akron in 1976 as a Bookkeeper, which led him to becoming a Teller, an Auditor, Vice President and Auditor, Vice President, Senior Vice President, Executive Vice President, President, and from 2002 to the present he has served as President, CEO, and CFO; and*

**WHEREAS**, *E. Peter Forrestel II is a member of the New York State Department of Financial Services and the Independent Bankers Association of New York State, where he served as Past President and has been acting Director since 1996; and was a former member of the New York State Banking Board; and*

**WHEREAS**, *E. Peter Forrestel II supported the community in various capacities over the years, including Board Member for the Akron Central School Board of Education; Trustee of the Erie 1 BOCES Board of Education, Group 1; Chairman of the New York Bankers Association; member of the East Hill Foundation, Coxswain Council; Trustee of The Nature Conservancy - Western New York Chapter; and a past member of the Akron-Newstead Recreation Board; and*

**WHEREAS**, *E. Peter Forrestel II has been a Trustee for the Village of Akron since 1997, having served as Deputy Mayor four times and is a member of the Police and Fire Services Committee, the Water/Wastewater Committee, and the Joint Municipal Highway Facility Committee; and*

**WHEREAS, E. Peter Forrestel II** is a Charter Member of the Akron-Newstead Rotary Club, having been Director for the past six years; is a member of the Akron Lions Club, having held the positions of Secretary, President, and Director; is a life member of the Newstead Historical Society, where he was a Trustee and Treasurer of the Rich-Twinn Octagon House; and is a member of the First United Methodist Church in Akron; and

Peter Forrestel II** has been involved in the organization of several community service projects including the Akron Central School all-weather track project; the Bike Path from Cedar Street to Hake Road and over Murder Creek Bridge; the original Rich-Twinn Octagon House restoration project; and has participated in various rehab projects with the Akron Lions Club, which oversees all aspects of Russell Park, including the gazebo, the pavilion, and the playground.
