ACCOMPANYING MEMORANDUM

RE: SRO Grant Funding for Alden, Holland, North Collins and Springville school districts
2016/2017

I. Summary of Recommended Action

The attached resolution requests authorization to allow the County of Erie and the Erie County Sheriff's Office to enter into any necessary agreements with the Erie 2 Chautauqua-Cattaraugus BOCES for a School Resource Officer. This agreement will fund a School Resource Office Deputy position for the 2016/2017 school year for the Alden, Holland, North Collins, and Springville school districts. The SRO within the aforementioned school districts will promote a safe environment and increase security for school buildings and grounds.

II. Fiscal Implications of Proposal

The Erie County Sheriff's Office will receive \$110,000.00 in grant funding.

III. Reasons for Recommendation

Erie County and Erie 2 Chautauqua-Cattaraugus BOCES need enter into a contract for School Resource Officer services for the 2016/2017 school year.

IV. Consequence of Negative Action

The Erie County Sheriff's Office will forfeit \$110,000.00 in legislative initiative grant funding.

V. Steps Following Approval of Measure

Certified copies of this resolution will be forwarded to the Division of Budget and Management, the Erie County Comptroller's Office, the County Attorney and the Erie County Sheriff's Office.

PROPOSED RESOLUTION

Re: SRO Grant Funding for Alden, Holland, North Collins and Springville school districts

WHEREAS, School Resource Officers (SROs) are vital to the safety of students, teachers and staff, in that SROs promote a safe environment in schools so the focus can be on instruction; and

WHEREAS, SRO serve a multifaceted purpose in our schools including serving as first responders for incident that occur on school campuses; and

WHEREAS, budget constraints have limited the ability of the Alden, Holland, North Collins and Springville school districts, to include SROs in their budgets, such that none of the districts are able to employ a SRO on their campuses; and

WHEREAS, New York State Senator Patrick Gallivan, has secured a one-hundred ten thousand dollar (\$110,000.00) legislative initiative grant to fund an SRO position to be shared by the districts for the 2016/2017 school year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the special legislative grant, Erie 2 Chautauqua-Cattaraugus BOCES (BOCES) shall serve as the contract coordinator for administrative purposes; and

WHEREAS, the sheriff has conferred with BOCES and the districts, and has agreed to provide and assign one uniformed Deputy to be shared among the districts as an SRO for the 2016/2017 school year; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of all parties that neither BOCES nor the districts will incur any additional expense for the Sheriff's provision of the uniformed Deputy Officer beyond the funds provided by the legislative initiative grant secured by Senator Gallivan's office; and

WHEREAS, the BOCES and the County, acting through the Erie County Sheriff's Office, desire to set forth in this agreement the specific terms and conditions of the services to be performed and provided by the Deputy as SRO in the districts; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature does hereby authorize the County Executive and the Erie County Sheriff's Office to enter into an agreement with Erie 2 Chautauqua-Cattaraugus BOCES for one (1) SRO Deputy Officer and to receive funding in the amount \$110,000 .00 for said position which will be shared among Alden, Holland, North Collins and Springville school districts; and

RESOLVED, this agreement is for the period of September 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017; and be it further

SUSPENSION

RESOLVED, BOCES will compensate the Erie County Sheriff's Office utilizing the aforementioned legislative initiative grant for the position of an SRO for the 2016/2017 school year; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the County Executive's Office, the Division of Budget and Management, the Office of the Comptroller, the County Attorney and the Office of the Sheriff.
