SUMMARY

The Village of Hamburg intends to design and construct pedestrian facilities on a County road. An agreement is necessary between the Village of Hamburg and County on this Village/Federal Aid project to allow this work to be performed and to spell out future maintenance of the pedestrian facilities.

WHEREAS, The Village of Hamburg (“Village”) intends to design and construct pedestrian facilities on a County owned roadway at Legion Drive (CR 134); and

WHEREAS, said pedestrian facilities shall be designed and constructed in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and with Federal and Village funds; and

WHEREAS, the Village shall be responsible for any and all maintenance aspects related to the pedestrian facilities; and

WHEREAS, an agreement between the Village and the County will be necessary to allow the Village to proceed with the design and construction of the pedestrian facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County Executive be authorized to execute an agreement between the County of Erie and the Village of Hamburg, allowing the Village to design, construct, and maintain pedestrian facilities located on Legion Drive (CR 134) in the Village of Hamburg; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature be directed to send one certified copy of the resolution to the County Executive; the County Attorney; and the Department of Public Works
