MEMORANDUM

SUMMARY

The STOP DWI/Traffic Safety unit in the Department of Central Police Services is seeking approval for the County Executive to accept funding from the New York Governor's Traffic Safety Committee and to establish a Traffic Safety Grant in their department.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There will be no impact on County funds. All grant expenditures are 100% reimbursable by the State. No local match is required.

REASONS FOR RECOMENDATION

The STOP DWI/Traffic Safety unit in the Department of Central Police Services will be allowed to accept State funding and utilize the funds to teach about traffic safety.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The New York Governor's Traffic Safety Committee (GTSC) has awarded Erie County \$17,850 to fund a part-time traffic safety instructor to make presentations at area high schools and community organizations, and purchase materials for distribution at Safety Awareness events.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

Failure to adopt this resolution will forfeit funding and end grant activities.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

Upon approval, the STOP-DWI Office will work with the Division of Budget & Management and the Division of Purchase to establish the grant and begin to purchase and distribute materials.

WHEREAS, the New York Governor's Traffic Safety Committee has awarded Erie County a grant in the amount of \$17,850; and

WHEREAS, the grant will be used to fund a part-time traffic safety instructor to present safe driving information and purchase materials for Traffic Safety Awareness Events; and

WHEREAS, all expenses under the Traffic Safety Program are 100% reimbursable by New York State with no local matching dollars required; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature does hereby authorize the County Executive to enter into contract with the New York Governor's Traffic Safety Committee to receive \$17,850 in grant funding for the STOP-DWI/Traffic Safety Department; and be it further
