WHEREAS, Isla Stadler picked out what kinds of seeds she wanted from a catalogue, mapped out her garden, and planted each seed herself, and;

WHEREAS, Isla Stadler's hard work paid off when her garden produced more than 40 pounds of vegetables, and;

WHEREAS, Isla Stadler's three-year-old brother, Arlo, suffers from rare form of kidney disease, and;

WHEREAS, Isla Stadler used her gardening talents and generous nature to develop a unique fundraiser to benefit her brother and The Kidney Project, and;

WHEREAS, Isla Stadler sold her produce, along with baked goods and lemonade, at the Main Street Marketplace in West Seneca, and;

WHEREAS, Isla Stadler is selling her vegetables, not only to help others stay healthy, but for a special intention, boosted by her family's pledge to match each dollar raised, and;

WHEREAS, Isla Stadler donated the profits to The Kidney Project, an organization run by a team of researchers at the University of California who are roughly five years away from launching an implantable artificial kidney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this legislative body pauses in its deliberations to honor Isla Stadler for efforts to raise funds and awareness for The Kidney Project.
