SUMMARY

The Erie County Legislature is requested to receive and file this communication pertaining to the Department of Environment and Planning's approval of a work order with AECOM (formerly URS Corporation) for Erie County Sewer District No. 3 in the amount of \$9,300.33.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There will be no fiscal impact to the County's General Fund. The cost of the engineering work related to this communication will be paid from Erie County Sewer District No. 3 Capital Account C.00012.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The Division of Sewerage Management has issued work order URS-7 to provide structural engineering services to assist Division of Sewerage Management personnel with the repair of damaged concrete in the existing Southtowns Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility Overflow Retention Facility.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On November 8, 2012, the Erie County Legislature passed a resolution (Comm. 18E-9 (2012)) authorizing a Term Agreement with URS Corporation, now known as AECOM. At the time of contract award, the Division of Sewerage Management committed to notifying the Honorable Legislature of each work order issued.

The Term Agreement was approved to provide the Division of Sewerage Management with consultant services required to complete various Professional Engineering tasks throughout the Erie County Sewer Districts.
