SUMMARY

The Erie County Legislature is requested to receive and file this communication pertaining to the Department of Environment and Planning's approval of a work order with DiDonato Associates for Erie County Sewer District No. 3 in an amount not to exceed \$50,500.00.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There will be no fiscal impact to the County's General Fund. The cost of the engineering inspection work related to this communication will be paid from the 2016 adopted Sewer Fund Operating Budget; Sewer Professional Services Account 516020 of Sewer District No. 3.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The Division of Sewerage Management has issued work order DI-5 to DiDonato Associates to provide resident engineering services. These funds will reimburse DiDonato Associates for inspection of various projects in Erie County Sewer District No. 3.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On December 12, 2013, the Erie County Legislature passed a resolution (Comm. 20E-9(2013)) authorizing a 3-year Term Agreement with DiDonato Associates. At the time of contract award, the Division of Sewerage Management committed to notifying the Honorable Legislature of each work order issued.

The Term Agreement was approved to provide the Division of Sewerage Management with engineering services required to complete various construction inspections throughout the Erie County Sewer Districts.


