- Our parcels are narrow and are only 100 feet wide (when the houses are factored in this equation, which only allows a distance of approximately 20 feet between the two premises) and the TWO HUNDRED foot distance is not an adequate distance.
- The definition of AGRICULTURAL brings a vast range of animals.
- The noise and smell that will encompass our surroundings.
- There will definitely be an increase of pests and vermin in our area.
- Our area is noticeably a "SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL NEIGHBORHOOD" and there are no other farm animals on our street.
