I HEREBY CERTIFY, *That at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 20th day of October, 2016 A.D., a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:*

WHEREAS, *The Erie County Legislature seeks to honor individuals and institutions of Erie County who enhance the quality of life in the community through their efforts; and*

WHEREAS, *Great Lakes Medical Imaging is the largest radiology group in the greater Buffalo area with approximately 100 employees; and*

WHEREAS, *Great Lakes Medical Imaging offers all aspects of diagnostic medical imaging, including low-dose CT, MRI, mammography, nuclear medicine, PET/CT, bone density, fluoroscopy, ultrasound and x-ray; and*
