I HEREBY CERTIFY, *That at a regular session of the Legislature of Erie County, held in the County Hall, in the City of Buffalo, on the 20th day of October, 2016, A.D., a resolution was adopted, of which the following is a true copy:*

WHEREAS, *Morgan Scheible lead Team Elderwood Assisted Living at Hamburg at the Walk to End Alzheimer's held September 17, 2016 in Buffalo; and*

WHEREAS, *Morgan Scheible and her team represent the spirit of the event that together we are stronger and can best fight Alzheimer's, improve treatments, and one day find a cure; and*

WHEREAS, *Morgan Scheible and Team Elderwood Assisted Living at Hamburg had more than 20 registered members and raised \$2,810, exceeding the team's goal by an astounding 562 percent, and did its part to fight Alzheimer's; and*

WHEREAS, *Morgan Scheible demonstrates how the fight must remain constant as she is dedicated to supporting the Alzheimer's Association in numerous ways, including being involved with Blondes vs. Brunettes, a fun rivalry event that raises awareness and funds; and*

WHEREAS, *Morgan Scheible, Team Elderwood Assisted Living at Hamburg, and every supporter of the Buffalo Walk to End Alzheimer's should be extremely proud of themselves with everyone doing their part to achieve the ultimate goal to "reclaim the future for millions."*
