RE: Erie County Sheriff's Office – Erie County Sheriff's Office – Authorization to enter into a contract with TheSheriffApp.com

### I. Summary of Recommended Action

The attached resolution requests authorization to allow the County of Erie to enter into any necessary agreements with the TheSheriffApp.com for a mobile device application, development, and service. This mobile app will allow individuals who own a mobile device but have limited access to a computer and the internet to access services provided by the Erie County Sheriff's Office. Furthermore, the mobile app will aid in the sheriff's office battle against crime and the growing narcotics epidemic.

# II. <u>Fiscal Implications of Proposal</u>

The cost of the application and necessary services are covered by previously authorized funds in COMM. 11E-29 approved by the legislature on April 14, 2016.

### III. Reasons for Recommendation

The legislature needs to authorize the County Executive and the Sheriff of Erie County to enter into an agreement between Erie County and TheSheriffsApp.com.

# IV. Consequence of Negative Action

The Erie County Sheriff's Office would be unable to utilize approved appropriations.

WHEREAS, this app has many features for up-to-the-minute alerts during emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, one of the key features will allow users who download the app to submit anonymous tips, with photos, about crimes and narcotic activity in their neighborhood; and

RESOLVED, that the Erie County Legislature does hereby authorize the County Executive and the Erie County Sheriff's Office to enter into an agreement with TheSheriffApp.com; and be it further
