As the Plant Engineer, I have supervised 17 employees, scheduled work hours, resolved conflicts, and determined salaries. We are responsible for maintaining the facility, and the equipment to extremely high standards. The facility houses a wide range of production equipment including, but not limited to CNC lathes and mills, hydraulic presses, induction heating process equipment, and vacuum heat treating furnaces. I have been directly involved in designing and implementing many of these systems. In addition there are three plating lines all of which are highly automated along with the waste water treatment systems needed to support them. We were involved in a 28,000 square foot building addition, which included upgrading many major systems. The electrical service was upgraded, along with the implementation of several major pieces of process equipment. The recent upgrade to fluorescent lighting from metal halide resulted in a 43% savings over the existing lighting while increasing the light levels approximately 33%. The team has designed, and fabricated several pieces of equipment that have made a major increase in production. Some of the systems I have designed have used primarily Allen-Bradley control systems including, PLC's, variable speed drives, servo drive systems, along with HMI systems including RSView, PanelView, and Panelview Plus applications. Programming systems included RSLogix 5, RSLogix 500, and RSLogix 5000. along with DirectSoft 32 and several others. AutoCad Electrical and Promise E drafting packages were used in the design and implementation as well. Much of the equipment is in automated material handling equipment. Some of the machines have used servo drives systems as well. I am fluent in the use of programs such as Micorsoft Word, Excel, and Front Page I have personally designed and implemented several different distributed database applications using Microsoft Access as well.
