This resolution is requesting your Honorable Body's authorization for the County Executive to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Erie Community College South Campus – 2017 Roof Repairs and Recoating - Rebid project. Bids were received by the Department of Public Works on November 14, 2017 and a copy of the bid tabulation for the project is attached for your reference. The County will receive 50% reimbursement from New York State for this project.

This project involves new white polyurethane reflective restoration finish coat over existing coating PVC membranes of entire roof surface on Buildings 1 to 7; wet area removal and infill at wet insulation areas; repair of peeling existing coated PVC membrane and standing water areas, and patching of single-ply membranes. The alternate price for a slip-resistant surfacing with an additional restoration finish coat will provide an additional five (5) year warranty, in addition to the ten (10) year warranty extension with the new roof restoration system.

SUMMARY

This resolution is requesting your Honorable Body's authorization for the County Executive to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Erie Community College South Campus – 2017 – Roof Repairs and Recoating – Rebid project.

This project involves new white polyurethane reflective restoration finish coat over existing coating PVC membranes of entire roof surface on Buildings 1 to 7; wet area removal and infill at wet insulation areas; repair of peeling existing coated PVC membrane and standing water areas, and patching of single-ply membranes, for warranty extension. Restoration of the roofs will preserve the buildings for a longer useful life.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Funds for the project are currently available from the approved, as adopted Erie County Capital Budget, SAP project E.15003 – 2015 ECC Roof Replacement & Waterproofing College wide.

The County will receive 50% reimbursement from New York State for this project.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The existing roof system for Buildings 1 to 7 has exceeded its useful life and to reduce maintenance costs associated with temporary "stop-gap" measures to keep the building weather tight, roof restoration is warranted. The alternate price for a slip-resistant surfacing with an additional restoration finish coat will provide an additional five (5) year warranty, in addition to the ten (10) year warranty extension with the new roof restoration system. Restoration of the roofs will preserve the buildings for a longer useful life.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Buildings 1 to 7 were originally completed in 1972, with a roof restoration system completed in 2010 for a warranty period of five (5) years. The condition of this 45 year old single-ply roof system had benefitted greatly from this last protective coating application work. The warranty has expired since 2015 and the roofs are slowly showing signs of deterioration with areas of existing coating peeling and water ponding.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

If this project is not completed, the roofs will continue to deteriorate with increasing areas of existing coating peeling and water ponding; which will lead to leaking and deterioration of the buildings.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL

Upon Legislative approval, the County Executive will enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder.

COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Comptroller's Office and is related to an authorized capital project for which there are sufficient appropriations for the action proposed.

WHEREAS, the Erie County Department of Public Works received bids for the Erie Community College South Campus – 2017 – Roof Repairs and Recoating – Rebid project on November 14, 2016, and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder for the Erie Community College South Campus – 2017 – Roof Repairs and Recoating - Rebid project is Grove Roofing Services Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Erie County Department of Public Works is recommending award of the contract to the lowest responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Erie Community College South Campus – 2017 – Roof Repairs and Recoating - Rebid project for an amount not to exceed as follows:

RESOLVED, that change order reductions will result in these funds being returned to the Construction Contingency Fund; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Comptroller's Office be authorized to make payment for the above from SAP Project Account as follows:

E.15003 – 2015 ECC Roof Replacement & Waterproofing College wide \$1,500,000 Total Payment Not To Exceed: \$1,500,000
