MEMORANDUM

SUMMARY

Erie County is embarking on Phase III of Improvements to the Black Rock Canal Park. This resolution requests authorization for the County Executive to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder, Union Concrete and Construction Corp., to construct the improvements.

FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed resolution requests that the \$298,400 in funding necessary for these improvements be allocated from the 2015 capital project A.15081, fund 410, business area 162 - Improvements to the Black Rock Canal Park. Additionally, we are requesting that \$45,000 be allocated from the project for construction contingencies. The source of funding for this project is from the New York State Power Authority – Greenway allocation process.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION

It is necessary that these approvals be granted, so that the contracts can be awarded to allow the contractors to order materials and begin construction work as soon as possible with the goal of being substantially complete during the current construction season.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Black Rock Canal Park is located along the Niagara River and is still in need of much repair and updating. The project will continue to implement new eco-friendly materials as a test pilot for future Erie County park improvements. Phase II of the park improvement project was completed in 2016. Phase II included the revamping of the main parking and boat launch area and the installation of a promenade along the river's edge, LED lighting, landscaping islands and uniform parking for cars and boat trailers. Phase III includes the extension of the boat launch, replacement of the existing dock area, addition of lighting, security cameras, and boat launch amenities.

CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION

Funding from the NYS Power Authority may be lost if the contracts are not approved and construction has not begun this year.

STEPS FOLLOWING APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION

The contracts will be awarded and construction will begin as soon as possible.

COMPTROLLERS OFFICE REVIEW

The proposed legislation has been reviewed by the Office of the Comptroller and is related to an authorized Capital Project A.15081.1, for which there are sufficient account balances for the action proposed.

WHEREAS, the County has been embarking on a \$2.5 million multi-phased improvement project to Black Rock Canal Park; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to start construction as soon as possible.

RESOLVED, that the County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder, for the Black Rock Canal Park Improvements Project Phase III construction project as follows:
