# A RESOLUTION TO BE SUBMITTED BY CHAIRMAN MILLS

RE: Appointment to the Erie County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board

WHEREAS, the Erie County Legislature established the Erie County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board (AFPB) on March 18, 1993 in accordance with New York State Agriculture and markets Law, Article 25-AA, Section 302(a); and

WHEREAS, New York State Agriculture and Markets Law, Article 25-AA, Section 302(b) states that the term of each member of the AFPB shall be four (4) years; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with New York State Agriculture and Markets Law, Article 25-AA, Section 302, members of the AFPB may be appointed by the Chairman of the County legislative body; and

WHEREAS, among the membership of the AFPB there shall be a member representing an organization dedicated to agricultural land preservation; and

WHEREAS, among the membership of the AFPB there shall be four (4) active farmers appointed to membership of this Board; and

WHEREAS, Nancy Smith of the Western New York Land Conservancy does not wish to be reappointed for another four (4) year term; and

WHEREAS, there is currently a vacant active farmer position on this Board; and

WHEREAS, the AFPB recommends that the Chair of the Legislature appoint Rachel Chrostowski and Leonard Janiga to the AFPB; and

WHEREAS, action is necessary to ensure Erie County Legislature representation on this important advisory body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that this honorable body hereby appoints, in her capacity as representative of an organization dedicated to agricultural land preservation, Rachel Chrostowski of the Western New York Land Conservancy located at the Kenneglenn Nature Preserve in East Aurora with a mailing address of PO Box 471, East Aurora, New York 14052, to the Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this honorable body hereby appoints, in his capacity as a farmer, Leonard Janiga of Maelen Farms located at 11121 Jamison Road, East Aurora, New York 14052, to the Erie County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board; and be it further
